Explanation of: How We Determine Which Recipients Qualify to Receive Payments

Scholarship applications are received and checked for completeness by the United States Army Warrant Officers Association (USAWOA) staff. Each application is placed in an individual folder and filed for processing.

A independent selection committee composed of senior warrant officers are recruited to review and evaluate each application. Committee members are not eligible to serve on the committee if they are in any way related to the scholarship applicants.

Approximately two weeks after the scholarship application cut-off date, applications are turned over to an independent selection committee to stratify the candidates in an Order of Merit listing. The listing is returned along with the applications to the Foundation Executive Director.

The number of scholarships to be awarded are determined by the Board of Directors. Based upon the number of scholarships that may be awarded during that cycle, the Executive Director notifies the scholarship recipients that they were selected and requests the recipients complete an additional form wherein full information about the educational institution the scholarship recipient will attend or is attending, including the student identification number at the institution.

When the requested additional information form is received from the recipient of the scholarship a letter and check are sent sent to the educational institution, the awardee will be attending or is attending, advising the institution that a scholarship has been awarded, and the acceptable use of the scholarship funds (tuition, books, lab fees, etc.) for the recipient of the scholarship. At no time are any funds paid directly to the scholarship recipient.
