The Selection Committee worked very hard on Saturday 10 July 2010 and completed the review of the applications we received for scholarships this cycle. A total of 27 applicants were received, one was not qualified to submit and one was mailed 20 days after the cutoff date and disallowed. Of the 25 valid applications we are able to fund seventeen (17) \$1,000.00 scholarships this year, based on the funds available.

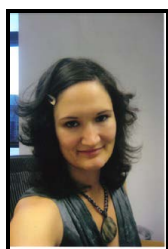
